Packing Suggestions

Think layers when packing clothing - temperatures this time of year can range from the 30's to 80's

Bring:

- Plenty of socks; plan on getting many miles of walking type exercise
- Small Bible for street ministry
- Rain poncho or raincoat
- Sunscreen
- Old shoes; the Bourbon St. area can get a bit "unkempt" as the night progresses - as in beer and garbage flowing in the streets.
- Sleeping bag
- Air mattress or cot
- There will be an area for cots/air mattresses if you prefer not to sleep in a bunk bed
- Bunk beds available
- Pillow
- **EAR PLUGS** - if you want to get some sleep at night
- Toiletries - including towel, soap, etc.
- Hand sanitizer

Food: The registration fee includes 2 meals per day - usually breakfast and supper - from Saturday through Monday.

The first provided meal will be **Friday** supper.

Tuesday breakfast will be provided - Tuesday lunch and supper may NOT be provided - it depends on our final specific camp schedule.

Bring at least \$150 for approximately 8 meals not provided at camps

- 2 breakfasts (Friday & Wednesday)
- 1 supper (Tuesday)
- 5 lunches (Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday)
